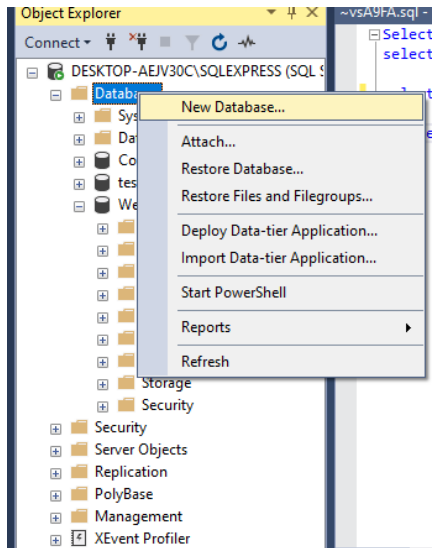


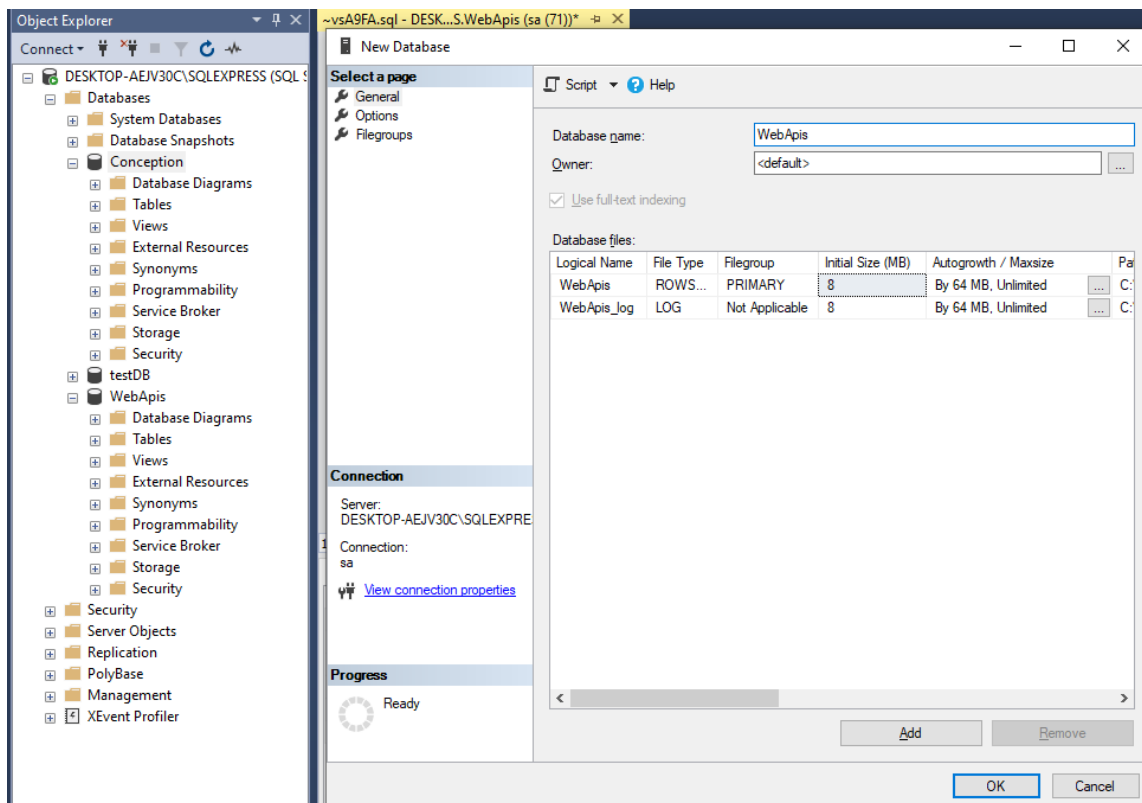

## CREATING DATA BASE AND TABLES

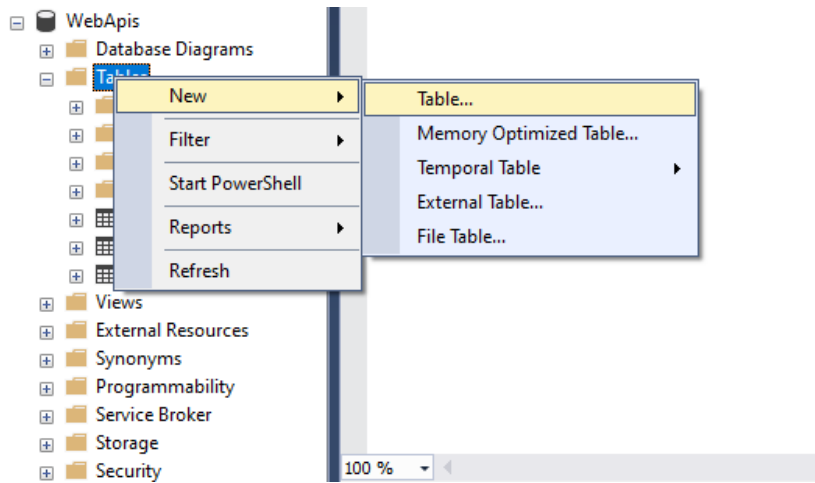
- Open MSSQL server Management Studio
- Right click on Data Base and Select New Data Base



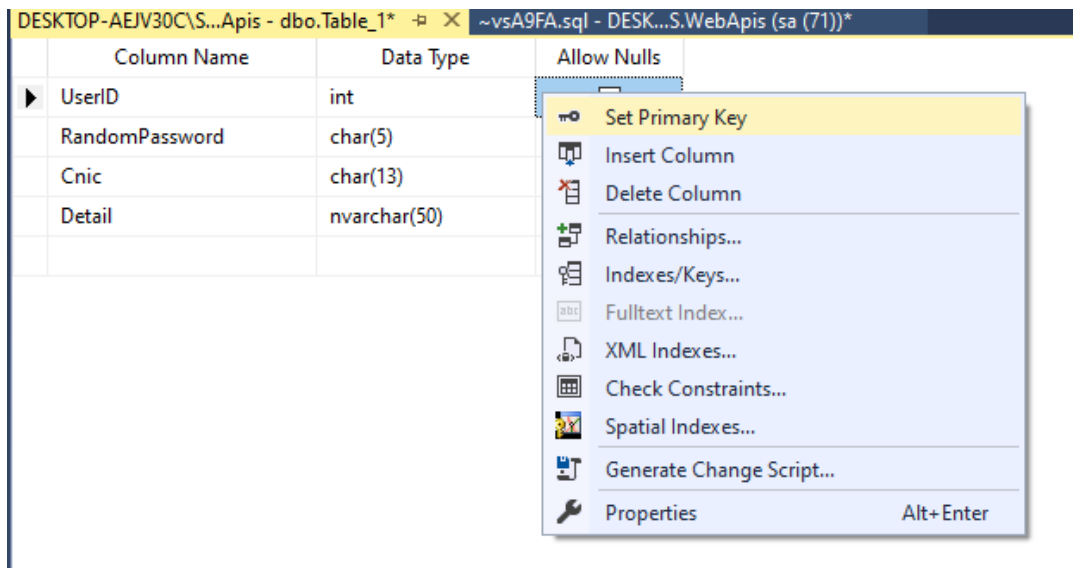
- Write Data Base Name and Click Ok

- Click on column and select Identity On to auto increment of number
- And you can also change Identity Seed to start auto increment with your required number
